

The Department of Civil, Construction, and Environmental Engineering at North Carolina State University invites applications for the non-tenure track position of Lecturer and Senior Construction Extension Specialist available for appointment beginning immediately. Applicants must have BS and Master's degrees in Construction Engineering, Civil Engineering, Architectural Engineering, or Mechanical Engineering. Experience in the construction industry in a leadership and decision making capacity is required. A Professional Engineer license or a commitment to become licensed is expected.

The Construction Extension program was initiated in 1964 as a cooperative effort between the University, industry and government. It is a key element of the department's overall activities. In recent years, the extension program has offered about 75 seminars annually and short courses with about 4000 participants. An important focus for the future will be to expand this outreach program regionally and nationally. The successful candidate will be expected to play an integral role in carrying out the extension mission of the department and to share in the teaching mission of the Construction Engineering and Management degree program.

The department has approximately 40 faculty, 800 undergraduate students, 250 graduate students, and excellent facilities (www.ce.ncsu.edu). Three ABET-accredited undergraduate degrees are offered, a BS in Civil Engineering, a BS in Construction Engineering and Management, and a BS in Environmental Engineering. The Construction Engineering and Management BS program was the first accredited construction degree program in the nation and has about 2500 graduates. Masters and PhD degrees are also offered in the construction engineering and management specialty. The Master of Civil Engineering in the construction engineering and management specialty is also available through distance education.
