

FACULTY POSITION, DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL & ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING, VIRGINIA MILITARY INSTITUTE (VMI). The Civil & Environmental Engineering Department invites applications for one full-time tenure-track faculty position in the general area of structural engineering at the assistant or associate professor level. Candidates must have an earned doctorate in Civil Engineering, or a related discipline, and must have excellent teaching and communication skills. Industry experience is preferred and professional registration, or the ability to obtain registration within two years of appointment, is required. The appointment begins 1 August 2008. The department is ABET accredited in Civil Engineering and VMI is a public, four-year undergraduate military college for men and women (1400 students). The successful candidates will be expected to teach a variety of basic engineering and junior and senior design courses, advise/supervise students, and engage in scholarly and/or professional activity. Performance is evaluated on the basis of 1) teaching, 2) scholarly engagement, 3) professional citizenship, and 4) cadet development.
